Soleil Identite £25, by Chanel (020 7493 3836). The best fake tan for the face. It smells amazing, moisturises, works well under make-up and never turns the skin orange.

Designer Shaping Cream Foundation SPF 20, £45, by Giorgio Armani, from Selfridges (020 7318 2486). I've turned many non-foundation-wearing women into devout addicts with this beautifully textured one, including my mum.

Shimmering Skin Perfector £32, by Becca (beccacosmetics.com). A gorgeous highlighter that gives an incredible glow, without any horrible glitter or sparkly bits. Dab this on to the cheekbones to give them a pop, or to slim down the face slightly

Eye Basics Palette £32, by Bobbi Brown (0870 034 2566). A smart little box that contains everything you need. The colours are so wearable and the textures so soft.

Tinted Lip Conditioner SPF15 £10.28, by MAC (maccosmetics.co.uk). Nobody wants to wear make-up on the beach, but a slightly glossy tint looks lovely. My favourite is Gentle Coral.
