

YOUR post-party FACE SAVERS

WHETHER YOU HAVE 60 SECONDS OR 30 MINUTES, HERE ARE THE SKIN-PEPPING SECRETS TO REVITALISE YOUR LOOKS THE MORNING AFTER THE NIGHT BEFORE

Try one of these instant retouchers

FOR THE SKIN

Right now, restoring skin's luminosity is your top priority. So reach for an illuminating powder or cream highlighter, as these create a smooth, gleaming surface. My go-to product when I need to brighten a dull complexion is bareMinerals Ready Luminizer in The Love Affair, £26 (2) - a shimmering warm shade pink that creates a lit-from-within glow. Or if your skin is especially dry, sweep Illamasqua's dewy Glean Highlighter in Aurora, £18, down the bridge of your nose, across the top of your cheek and brow bones and dab a little on your cupid's bow. Blend away sharp edges using your finger.

FOR THE EYES

A yellow- or orange-based concealer will help to knock out the bluey-brown tones of dark circles, says make-up artist Lizzie Herbeson. 'But avoid applying it underneath the entire eye. Instead, concentrate on the dark semicircle in the inside corner of your eye, which extends down to the

bridge of your nose, as this helps to stop the concealer sitting in any fine lines. For the best results, try Bobbi Brown Cream Corrector in Peach, £18 (3), or Rimmel London Wake Me Up Concealer, £5.99.

FOR THE CHEEKS

Blushers sound like they should automatically perk up a dull complexion, but not all are flattering. 'Coral shades of

cream blusher will brighten the face and look beautiful against all skin tones,' says Herbeson. 'Just steer clear of pinkier tones, which can sometimes add to the blotchiness of tired skin.' For beauty emergencies, I keep Benefit Fine Ore Ore, £21.50 (3), to hand, as it blends together sheer shades of soft peach, watermelon and coral - basically all the hues that occur naturally in flushed skin. Or try Tom Ford Lip & Cheek Stain in Tainted Love, £26.

FOR THE LIPS

Lips can be up to 10 times drier than other parts of the face or body - and that's only exacerbated by the dehydrating effects of alcohol. For a super-hydrating pop of colour, choose Soap & Glory Soxy Mother Pucker Gloss Stick in Fuchsia-Blaste, £8, with collagen-boosting peptides for fuller-looking lips. Or Clinique Chubby Stick Intense Moisturizing Lip Colour Balm in Chubby Cherry, £16 (4), which contains the same butter as the original but now has a more intense colour pay off. →
